(2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via (i) Mounts Pond Road, Hare and Billet Road, Wat Tyler Road, Lewisham Hill and Eliot Hill; (ii) Lewisham Hill, Wat Tyler Road, Hare and Billet Road, Mounts Pond Road; and (iii) Mounts Pond Road and the eastern arm of Granville Park, and vice versa.
- Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
 The order comes into force on the 30th May 2023 to remain in force
- The order comes into force on the 30th May 2023 to remain in force for up to 5 months. (Note: Works to be done is two phases, the closure of Granville Park is proposed for 30th May to 6th August and that for Mounts Pond Road from 2nd July to 6th August).
