ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A41 GLA ROAD (BAKER STREET, CITY OF WESTMINSTER)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable footway excavation works to take place on the A41 Baker Street.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from: (I) stopping in the loading bay outside Nos.230 to 238 Baker Street;
 - (2) stopping in the parking & disabled persons vehicles bay outside No.202 Baker Street:
 - (3) stopping in the disabled persons vehicles only bay outside Farley Court, Allsop Place:
 - (4) stopping in the loading bay opposite Nos.19 to 25 Park Road, except coaches:
 - (5) turning right from Allsop Place southbound into Station Approach. Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 12:01 AM on the 14th May 2023 and 7:00 PM on the 13th November 2024 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs.
