ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3214 GLA ROAD (BUCKINGHAM PALACE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) (No.2) ORDER 2023

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable a water disconnection works to take place on the A3214 Buckingham Palace Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) stopping on Grosvenor Gardens between its junctions with Beeston Place and Buckingham Palace Road,
 - (2) stopping in the Loading Bay outside Nos.26 to 30 Buckingham Palace Road.

The order will also prohibit buses from entering or proceeding in a northerly direction on Buckingham Palace Road between its junctions with Terminus Place and Victoria Street.

The Order will be effective between 8:00 AM on the 5th June until 5:30 PM on the 2nd August 2023 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Grosvenor Gardens and Lower Grosvenor Place to normal route of travel.
