ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3 GLA ROAD (CLAPHAM ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable telecommunication works to take place on the A3 Clapham Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from;
 - (1) Entering or exiting Clapham Road at its junction with Caldwell Street.
 - (2) Stopping in the loading, unloading and disabled persons' vehicles bay outside Nos.170-174 Clapham Road.The Order will be effective between 12th June 2023 and 17th June 2023 every night from 9:00 PM until 05:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via (to access Caldwell Street from Clapham Road) Clapham Road, Camberwell New Road and Brixton Road to normal route of travel. (to access Clapham Road from Caldwell Street) Caldwell Street, Brixton Road, Stockwell Road and Clapham Road to normal route of travel.
