

Transport for London Notice

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3204 GLA ROAD (KENNINGTON LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable electrical infrastructure installation works to take place at Kennington Lane.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle with a maximum gross weight in excess of 7.5 tonnes from:

- (1) turning right from Montford Place into Kennington Lane;
- (2) turning left from Kennington Lane into Montford Place.

The effect of the Order also prohibits any vehicle to:

- (3) stop in the Loading, Unloading and Disabled Persons' vehicles bay sited on Montford Place and adjacent to 247 Kennington Lane.

The Order will be effective at certain times 27th May 2023 and 18th June 2023, every Saturday at 8:00 AM until Sunday at 6:00 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Kennington Lane, Durham Street, A202 Harleyford Road and Kennington Lane to normal route of travel.
