ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3203 AND A3036 GLA ROADS (LAMBETH BRIDGE, LAMBETH ROAD, LAMBETH PALACE ROAD AND ALBERT EMBANKMENT, CITY OF WESTMINSTER AND LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC, STOPPING AND SUSPENSION OF BUS LANE) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable survey works to take place on the A3203 Lambeth Bridge.
3. The effects of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from;
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on the A3202 Lambeth Bridge between its junctions with Millbank and Albert Embankment/ Lambeth Palace Road;
 - (2) stopping on Albert Embankment between its junctions Lambeth Bridge and Tinworth Street.

The Order will also allow all vehicles to:

- (3) use the bus lane on Lambeth Palace Road between its junctions with Royal Street and Lambeth Bridge;
- (4) use the bus lane on Lambeth Road between its junctions with Pratt Walk and Albert Embankment;
- (5) use the bus lane on Lambeth Bridge between its junctions with Millbank and Albert Embankment/ Lambeth Palace Road;
- (6) use the bus lanes on Albert Embankment between its junctions with Lambeth Bridge and Tinworth Street.

The Order will be effective from 12:01 AM 8th June 2023 until 11:59 PM 8th December 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via (for eastbound closure) Millbank, Vauxhall Bridge, Bridgefoot, Albert Embankment and reverse to normal route of travel (for westbound closure) Milbank, Abingdon Street, Parliament Square, Westminster Bridge Road and Lambeth Place Road and reverse to normal route of travel.
