ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A20 GLA SIDE ROAD (LEE PARK, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lewisham hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable carriageway repair works to take place on the A20 GLA Side Road – Lee Park.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding in a southerly direction on Lee Park between its junctions with Lee Terrace/ Lee Road and Lee High Road, local access will be maintained between Lee Terrace/ Lee Road and Arne Walk.
The Order will be effective at certain times from 8:00 AM on the 25th May 2023 until 4:30 PM on the 15th June 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Lee Road and Lee High Road to normal route of travel.
