ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA ROAD (NEW CROSS ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable sewer works to take place on the A2 New Cross Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons' Vehicles bay outside Nos. 166 to 168 New Cross Road;(2) stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons' Vehicles bay outside
 - (2) stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons' Vehicles bay outside Nos. 174 to 176 New Cross Road.
 The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 AM on the 7th

June 2023 until 7:00 PM on the 8th August 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
