ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

A306 GLA ROAD (ROEHAMPTON LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable major excavation works to upgrade telecom masts to take place on Roehampton Lane.3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning left
- into Roehampton Lane from A3 Kingston Road.

 The Order will be effective at certain times between the 15th May 2023 and 26th May 2023, every night, from Monday to Friday, from at 9:00
 - PM to 5:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a polic constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Kingston Road, Putney Hill, Upper Richmond Road, Roehampton Lane to normal route of travel.
