Pope's Road. 2 Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be

available via (i) Brixton Road (northbound), Stockwell

Road, Stockwell Park Walk, Brixton Road (southbound). Gresham Road, Wiltshire Road and Pope's Road; and (ii)

Brixton Station Road, Gresham Road and Brixton Road, 3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such

extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. 4. The Order would come into force on 3rd July 2023 and

would continue for a maximum duration of 12 months (to

allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
