ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – KINGSMEAD ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable new water main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Kingsmead Road that lies between a point opposite the south-eastern boundary of the driveway to No. 70 Kingsmead Road southwards to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 66 and 68 Kingsmead Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Northstead Road and Palace Road and vice versa.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The ban referred to in paragraph 1 above would not apply to resident's vehicles or emergency vehicles requiring access to properties in that length of Kingsmead Road, provided the extent of the said works makes this possible.

5. The Order would come into force on 3rd July 2023 and continue in force for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 3rd July and 17th July 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
