

## **LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**

### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – SOUTHBANK SPINE ROUTE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Public Realm improvement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with the Transport for London, intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering:

- (a) Beehive Place, the whole length;
- (b) that section of Belvedere Road, which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Chicheley Street and the south-western end of Upper Ground;
- (c) that section of Brixton Station Road, which lies between the eastern kerb-line of Brixton Road and the western kerb-line of Popes Road;
- (d) Concert Hall Approach, the whole length;
- (e) the south-east bound slip road between Upper Ground and Waterloo Bridge, the whole length;
- (f) the north-west bound slip road between Belvedere Road and Waterloo Bridge, the whole length;
- (g) that section of Upper Ground, which lies between north-eastern end of Belvedere Road and the boundary of The London Borough of Southwark (adjacent to the western kerb-line of the north to south arm of Barge House Street).

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via (i) Brixton Road, Stockwell Road, Stockwell Park Walk, turn right not A23 Brixton Road, Gresham Road, Wiltshire Road, Canterbury Crescent, Popes Road; (ii) Brixton Station Road, Gresham Road, Brixton Road; (iii) Brixton Road, Atlantic Road, Coldharbour Lane, Gresham Road, Wiltshire Road, Canterbury Crescent, Popes Road; (iv) Belvedere Road, South East Bound Slip Road between Upper Ground and Waterloo Road, Waterloo Road roundabout; (v) Belvedere Road, Chicheley Street, York Road

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 18th June 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier.
