

LICENSING ACT 2003

Application for Grant of Premises Licence

Ms Eden Bekit has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the grant of a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises:

The Brickstone, 256-258 Brixton Road, London, SW9 6AQ which would authorise the following licensable activities:

Indoor Sporting Events every day between the hours of 11:00 and 00:00; Live Music on Thursday between the hours of 19:00 and 00:00, Friday to Saturday between the hours of 11:00 and 04:00 and Sunday between the hours of 11:00 and 00:00; Recorded Music Monday to Wednesday between the hours of 11:00 and 00:00, Thursday between the hours of 19:00 and 02:00, Friday to Saturday between the hours of 11:00 and 04:00 and Sunday between the hours of 11:00 and 00:00; Performances of Dance Sunday to Thursday between the hours of 11:00 and 00:00, Friday to Saturday between the hours of 11:00 and 04:00; Provision of Late Night refreshment Sunday to Thursday between the hours of 23:00 and 00:00, Friday to Saturday between the hours of 23:00 and 04:00; Supply of Alcohol Sunday to Wednesday between the hours of 11:00 and 00:00, Thursday between the hours of 11:00 and 02:00, Friday to Saturday between the hours of 11:00 and 04:00.

The record of this application may be inspected during normal office hours by an appointment at the Licensing Section, London Borough of Lambeth, 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG, or via the licensing authority's website, at www.lambeth.gov.uk/licensing

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to licensing@lambeth.gov.uk and must be received no later than 28th June 2023.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
