## **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

### **The Lewisham (Devonshire Road, SE23)**

#### **(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Devonshire Road, SE23 between the northern and southern arms of Boveney Road. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Boveney Road, Hengrave Road, Honor Oak Road, Honor Oak Park and Devonshire Road, and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 11th June 2023 to remain in force for up to 2 months. (Note: Works are planned to be carried out between 11th and 16th June, but additional duration has been allowed in case of cancellation).
- 4.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
