Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Upwood Road, SE12)

(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made the above named temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway in Burnt Ash Road. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Upwood Road, SE12, between Burnt Ash Road and Leewood Close. (2) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the prohibition are via Burnt Ash Road, Dorville Road, Cambridge Drive and Upwood Road, and vice versa.
- 2.** No parking/waiting in Burnt Ash Road between the projected southern boundary of the Lee Green United Reformed Church and the projected northern kerblines of Holme Lacey Road.
- 3.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 4.** The order continues the prohibitions brought into force by a RTRA s14(2) Notice, and comes into force on the 20th June 2023 to remain in force until 31st August if required.
- 5.** The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
