ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A202 GLA SIDE ROAD (BOLTON CRESCENT, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER (No.2) 2023

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water valve works to take place on the A202 Camberwell New Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering or exiting Bolton Crescent at its junction with Camberwell New Road;
 - (2) stopping in the Parking and Disabled Persons Vehicles Bay outside Nos.70-78 Bolton Crescent.The Order will be effective from 12:01 AM 12th June 2023 until 11:59 PM 25th June 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. Eastbound vehicles via Camberwell New Road, John Ruskin Street, Dale Road, Cooks Road, Kennington Park Place and St Agnes Place to normal route of travel. Westbound vehicles via Camberwell New Road, Harleyford Street, Kennington Oval, Harleyford Street, Kennington Park Road, Kennington Park Place and St Agnes Place to normal route of travel.
