

Transport for London Notice

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A3 GLA ROAD (BOROUGH HIGH STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) NO.2 ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London having consulted the London Borough of Southwark hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge repair and refurbishment works to take place at A3 Borough High Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering:
 - (1) Railway Approach at its junction with Borough High Street/Duke Street Hill;
 - (2) Guildable Manor Street at its junction with London Bridge.The notice also prohibits any person from entering, exiting or proceeding on the:
 - (3) footway sited at the nosing at the junction of Duke Street Hill with Railway Approach;
 - (4) southern footway of Railway Approach between Borough High Street and Guildable Manor Street;
 - (5) southern footway of Guildable Manor Street between London Bridge Street and railway Approach.The Order will be effective at certain times between 30th June 2023 and 24th September 2023 each night Monday to Friday 1:00 AM to 5:30 AM and weekends of 8th July 2023 to 10th July 2023, 25th August 2023 to 28th August 2023 and 16th August 2023 to 18th August 2023 (11:00 PM each Saturday to 5:30 AM on the Monday) or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs for pedestrians to utilise the western footway of Borough High Street and northern footway of Duke Street Hill via the appropriate crossings to normal route of travel. Bus diversion routes from Borough High Street: Marshalea Road, Southwark Bridge Road, Southwark Street to normal route of travel; Great Dover Street, Tabard Street, Nebraska Street, Great Dover Street to normal route of travel.
