I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that on 30th May 2023 it made the above named Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Orders will come into force on 5th June 2023. 2. The Roads effected by this Order are A3212 Chelsea Embankment,

Remove the loading and unloading and disabled persons' vehicle

- Grosvenor Road and Millbank
- 3. The general nature and effects of the Orders would be to;
 - (I) Prohibit any vehicle to turn left into Chelsea Bridge Road from
 - Chelsea Embankment;
 - (2) Prohibit any vehicle to turn right into Chelsea Bridge Road from the
 - A3212 Grosvenor Road except local buses;
 - (3) Prohibit any vehicle to turn left into Chelsea Bridge from the A3212 Grosvenor Road except pedal cycles;
 - (4) Prohibit any vehicle to turn right into Lupus Street from Grosvenor Road:
 - bay adjacent to No.I Paxton Terrace, Grosvenor Road replacing it with double red lines (no stopping at any time);

- (6) Prohibit any vehicle to turn left into Claverton Street from Grosvenor Road except buses, pedal cycles and taxis;
- (7) Prohibit any vehicle to turn right into the western arm of St
- George's Square from Grosvenor Road;
- (8) All vehicles proceeding on the western arm of St George's Square
- must turn left only upon reaching its junction with Grosvenor Road;
- Prohibit any vehicle to turn left into Bessborough Gardens from Grosvenor Road except pedal cycles;
- replacing it with double red lines (no stopping at any time); (11) Change the operational timings of the bus bay adjacent to No.44a Millbank from "No Stopping At Any Time except buses pick up or
- set down only to No Stopping At Any time except buses max I hour no return within 2 hours; (12) Convert the existing single red line (No Stopping Mon-Fri 7am-7pm)

(10) Remove the loading and unloading bay outside Nos.48-57 Millbank

- to double red line (No Stopping At Any Time) on the A3212 Grosvenor Road both sides between its junctions with Lupus Street and Bessborough Garden; (13) Convert the existing single red line (No Stopping Mon-Fri 7am-7pm)
- to double red line (No Stopping At Any Time) on the A3212 Millbank both sides between its junctions with Bessborough Garden and Lambeth Bridge. 4. A copy of the Orders, a map indicating the location and effect of the Orders and copies of any Orders revoked, suspended or varied by the
