(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER
2023

1. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster

- hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.

 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable signal modernisation works to
- take place on the A3214 Buckingham Palace Road.

 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping in
- the City of Westminster controlled bays opposite Nos. 48 to 52 Grosvenor Gardens. The Order will also prohibit any bus from entering or proceeding in a northerly direction on Buckingham Palace Road between its junctions
 - with Grosvenor Gardens and Victoria Street.

 The Order will be effective at certain times from 7:00 AM on 26th June 2023 until 7:00 PM on 26th October 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
- indicated by traffic signs.

 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be

indicated by traffic signs.
