ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE GLA ROAD AND GLA SIDE ROADS (LAMBETH) RED ROUTE CONSOLIDATION TRAFFIC ORDER 2007 THE A23 KENNINGTON ROAD VARIATION ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that on 20th June 2023 it made the above named Order, under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into force on 26th June 2023.
2. The general nature and the effect of the Order will be to formalise the “No Stopping At Any Time” (double red lines) on the A23 Kennington Road both sides between its junctions with Stannary Street and outside No.381 Kennington Road.
3. The road which would be affected by the Order is the A3 GLA Road – Kennington Road in the London Borough of Lambeth.
4. A copy of the Order, a map indicating the location and effect of the Order and copies of any Order revoked, suspended or varied by the Order can be inspected by appointment at our offices at the address below by emailing trafficordersection@tfl.gov.uk. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
