THE A24 GLA ROAD (MERANTUN WAY, LONDON BOROUGH OF MERTON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the abovenamed Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable traffic signal repair works take place on a section of the A24 Merantun Way.
 The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering.
- exiting or proceeding the westbound carriageway of Merantun Way between its junction with Christchurch Road and a point 18 metres east of the extended common boundary of Nos.27 and 33 Chapter Way The Order will be effective between 15th June 2023 and 17th June 2023 each night from 9:30 PM to 3:00 AM or when those works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;

anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police

- constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.

- At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via: Christchurch Road, Priory Road, Merton High Street, Morden Road and Merantun Way to normal route of travel.
