

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES FOR
CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING AND PUBLIC
REALM IMPROVEMENT WORKS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable carriageway resurfacing and public realm improvement works (including the installation of a new cycle lane and zebra pedestrian crossings) to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of:-

- (a) Dalkeith Road, which lies between its junction with Rosendale Road and Turney Road and a point 13 metres east of that junction;
- (b) Rosendale Road,
 - (i) which lies between No. 243 Rosendale Road and a point 10 metres south of the southern arm of Lovelace Road;
 - (ii) which lies between No. 187 Rosendale Road and a point 25 metres south of the southern arm of Lovelace Road;
 - (iii) which lies between the southern arm of Lovelace Road and Thurlow Park Road;
- (c) Turney Road, which lies between No. 10 Turney Road and its junction with Rosendale Road.

2. Alternative routes will be available for vehicles affected by the bans described in paragraph 1(a), (b) and (c) above, via adjacent roads, as indicated by traffic signs.

3. The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 24th July 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 3 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier.
