CHANGES TO THE HOURS OF OPERATION OF THE PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE ZONES BONNEVILLE GARDENS, BURGOYNE ROAD, AND LOWDEN ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 14 July 2023 made the Lambeth (Prescribed Routes) (No. 5) Traffic Order 2023 under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The Order will come into force on 24 July 2023.

2. The general effect of the Order will be to change the operational hours of the pedestrian and cycle zones Mondays to Fridays during school term-time in: -

(a) **Bonneville Gardens**, from the current zone operational hours of 8.15 am and 9.15 am and 2.45 pm and 3.45 pm, to the new operational hours of 8.30 am and 9.30 am and 3 pm and 4 pm.

(b) **Burgoyne Road**, from the current zone operational hours of 8.15 am and 9.15 am and 2.45 pm and 3.45 pm, to the new operational hours of 8.30 am and 9.30 am and 3 pm and 4 pm.

(c) **Lowden Road**, from the current zone operational hours of 8 am and 9 am and 3 pm and 4 pm, to the new operational hours 8.15 am and 9.15 am and 3 pm and 4 pm.

3. The changes are necessary to reflect the needs of the schools and the arrival and departure times of the pupils and staff at the schools in the roads concerned and to promote a pleasant environment that feels safer in the immediate vicinity of a school whilst seeking to minimise disruption to permit holders.

6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Order or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
