south of the junction with Comet Street for 4 metres in a southerly direction. b) CREEKSIDE - introduce a loading only bay (24 hours) on the north side from a point 3 metres southwest of the extended southwestern building line of No 4 Creekside southwest for 8 metres to abut with existing double yellow lines.

c) HEREFORD PLACE - replace all existing Mon - Sat 8am - 6.30pm single yellow lines with no waiting at any parking place. d) ROYAL NAVY PLACE -

time double yellow lines retaining the existing unrestricted replace existing Mon - Sat 8am - 6.30pm single yellow lines on both sides west of a point 21m west of the junction with Amersham Vale to the western extent and
