Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

The Lewisham (Various Roads) (Garage Nation Festival 2023) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council intends to make this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and section 287 of the Highways Act 1980 to facilitate the holding of the Garage Nation Festival 2023 in Mountsfield Park, SE6. The effects of the order will be as indicated below.

- 1.** (1) Road closures, prohibiting any vehicle from entering or proceeding in (i) George Lane; SE6 between Davenport Road and Stainton Road; (ii) George Lane, SE6 between Stainton Road and Hither Green Lane, in any direction other than eastwards; and (iii) Stainton Road, SE6 between Mountfield Close and George Lane, in any direction other than northwards.
(2) The alternative routes for traffic affected will be via (i) Hither Green Lane, Torridon Road, A205 Brownhill Road and Stainton Road, and vice versa; and (ii) Hither Green Lane, Springrice Road and George Lane, and vice versa.
- 2.** No waiting at any time for any purpose including loading & unloading in (i) Stainton Road, SE6 between Brownhill Road and George Lane; and (ii) George Lane, SE6 between Davenport Road and Hither Green Lane.
- 3.** Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the event, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency, and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer.
- 4.** The order is intended to come into force on the 12th August 2023 to remain in force for two days. The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
