ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIXTON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above-

- named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gas works to take place on the A23 Brixton Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding on Prima Road between its junctions with Brixton Road and Offley Road.
 The Order will be effective between 24th July 2023 and 29th July 2023

every night from 9:00 PM until 05:00 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a polici constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs (for southbound traffic) Brixton Road and Offley Road to normal route of travel. (for northbound traffic) Camberwell New Road, Kennington Park Road and Prima Road to normal route of travel.
