ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A20 GLA ROAD (LEE HIGH ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the abovenamed Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable chamber excavation works to take place on the A20 Lee High Road.3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on
- Lee High Road between the eastern arm of Marischal Road and the extended common boundary of Nos.49 and 51 Lee High Road.

 Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

 The Order will be effective at certain times between 7:00 AM on 31st

July 2023 and 7:00 PM on 17th August 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a policic constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London
