ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (TOOLEY STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable telecommunications works to take place on the A200 Tooley Street.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering or proceeding in a north-westerly direction on Tooley Street between its junctions with Tanner Street and Fair Street;
 - (2) stopping on Tooley Street between its junctions with Tower Bridge Road and Queen Elizabeth Street.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective between 2nd August 2023 and 19th August 2023, every Wednesday to Saturday night 9:00 PM until 5:00 AM (ending 5:00 AM Saturday) or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Tanner Street, Druid Street, Crucifix Lane and Bermondsey Street to normal route of travel.
