ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (WESTHORNE AVENUE, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London in consultation with the Royal Borough of Greenwich hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water connection works to take place on the A205 Westhorne Avenue:
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on the unnamed service road fronting Nos.546 to 558 Westhorne Avenue, access will be maintained to Nos.546-550 with exit permitted via the access gate fronting 552 Westhorne Avenue;
 - (2) stopping in the parking bays outside Nos.552 and 554 Westhorne Avenue.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 8:00 AM on the 17th July 2023 until 7:00 PM on the 28th July 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs.
