ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – BRIXTON STATION ROAD AND POPE'S ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Telecommunications upgrade works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of:-

(a) Brixton Station Road, west of the junction with Pope's Road and a point 15 metres east of Pope's Road.

(b) Pope's Road, which lies between its junction with Brixton Station Road and a point 15 metres north of that junction with Brixton Station Road.

(2) Suspend the one- way system and introduce a 2- way system in that length of:-

(i) Pope's Road, that lies between Canterbury Crescent & Brixton Station Road.

(ii) Brixton Station Road, which lies between Pope's Road & Gresham Road.

(iii) The Brixton Station Road Cycle Lane would remain unaffected.

3. The bans and suspension will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. An alternative route will be available for vehicles affected by the bans described in paragraph (1) and (2) via Pope's Road, Canterbury Crescent, Wiltshire Road and Gresham Road.

5. The Order will come into force on 5th September 2023, and it will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the bans will only apply between 5th September 2023 and 7th September 2023 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
