1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out safely

- in Herne Hill Boad, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:-(a) ban vehicles from entering that length of Herne Hill
 - Road, which lies between Coldharbour Laneand Padfield Road:
 - (b) impose a one-way system in Wanless Road in a direction from south-west to north-east (towards Herne Hill Road) (an alternative route will be available for affected vehicles via Herne Hill Boad
 - and Wingmore Road): (c) suspend the banned right turn from Denmark Hill
- into Herne Hill Road 2. Alternative routes will be available for vehicles affected by the restrictions referred to in paragraph 1(a) above, via
- (i) Coldharbour Lane, Denmark Hill and Herne Hill Road and Vice Versa: (ii) Coldharbour Lane, Gresham Road. Brixton Road, Effra Road, Morval Road, Dalberg Road, Dulwich Road, Norwood Road, Half Moon Lane and Herne Hill
- 3. The ban, suspension and one-way system will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.
- 4. The Order will come into force on 11th August 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed. whichever is the earlier. In practice, it is anticipated that the Order will only be in force from 11th August 2023 for 4 days, with back up dates of 18th to 21st August 2023 and 1st to 4th September 2023 but if the works cannot be
