To Mr Dosunmu

I allege that you have stepped outside your legal authority, jurisdiction and statutes and you are liable for all wrong doings done by Lambeth Council.

- 1) The UK Constitution is made up of the Bill of rights, the Human Rights Act 2019 and others etc. In The Human Rights Act it is unlawful for public authorities to act in a way that is inconsistent with our protected rights. The courts must interpret legislation so that it is consistent with our protected rights. I allege that my rights have been violated because of your policies, I list some below:
 - a) The incremental restrictions on road users for example ULEZ, parking policies, and road closures etc; contravene our unalienable right to travel within a state. Article 13 of the Universal Declaration of human rights specifies our right to move within a state.
 - b) Lambeth's Climate Action Plan (CAP) is globalist propaganda not based on scientific facts.
 - c) The incremental taxing of shops and retail outlets limits our purchasing options. This affects our rights to freely buy and sell goods and services in a free market.
 - d) The policy to monetize council land, property and influence for personal gain. I notice Lambeth Council has a D_U_N_S number (228216479) and you have a title as a CEO. This is all about business not community. It appears you are running the London borough of Lambeth as a money making business. My experiences and observations of Lambeth Council suggest creative accounting is at play.
 - e) The Covid19 policy. I and many others have been harmed by the roll out of the vaccine policy. The data and doctor's testimony support the fact that this policy has done more harm to the public than the disease itself.

If any of these policies infringe my rights then your legislation becomes null and void.

- 2) The UK Constitution grants powers to the Government and describes the Government. It describes the government as a de-jure Government. We have a de-facto Government. So if our Government has no powers granted by the Constitution where does the Council get its powers to set taxes when it is a sub office of a de-facto Government?
- 3) In the Independent Local government act 2000 part 1A chapter 2 Section 9D it states Functions are the responsibility of the executive. This makes you personally responsible for all the actions of the Council.

The harm and costs related to the above policies and not limited to the above, **if proven to be detrimental to the public**, are liable to you personally, ref Constitutional Reform and Governance Act 2010. It would seem that from your propaganda you do not seem to deliver. Under Consumer rights Act 2015 chapter 2 (11) goods, services and digital content are to be as stated Noscitur a Sociis. I give you 28 days to reply to my points and if I do not receive any reply **I will take further action**.
