**NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A NEW PREMISES LICENCE -  
LICENSING ACT 2003**

Notice is given that: **AnSCO Arena Limited** has applied for a new Premises Licence for The O2 Arena (the 'Premises'), Peninsula Square, London SE10 0DX in identical terms (relating to licensable activities and licensing hours\*) as apply under its existing Premises Licence 3623, save for the substitution of **The Residence @ The O2** on Level 3 (as shown on the licensing plans served with this application), in place of 12 suites on that Level, and consequential amendments to update the bespoke conditions. \*Standard Timings: Regulated Entertainment of all descriptions & the Sale of Alcohol (on & off): daily – in Arena Bowl, 08:00 to 00:00; in Non-Bowl areas, 08:00 to 03:00, and Late Night Refreshment, daily from 23:00 to 05:00. Non-Standard timings (limited to 20 occasions per annum) identical to existing Licence 3623 – See application form and draft conditions. **NB:** There are no changes to the internal layout of the 'Premises' (as identified in the plans annexed to the August 2023 Operations Manual) save as provided above. If the new Licence is issued in the terms sought, the existing Licence 3623 will be surrendered.

A record of this application may be inspected by appointment. Responsible Authorities and/or other persons may make Representations to the Council on the application by no later than **13 September 2023** (the application having been given on 16 August 2023).

Representations can be made in writing, by email or fax using the contact information as set out in the heading to this Notice. Representations can only be made within the above timescale and on grounds of one/or more of the four licensing objectives, namely: the protection of children from harm, the prevention of public nuisance, prevention of crime and disorder and public safety.

Any person who makes a false statement in connection with an application is liable on summary conviction to an unlimited fine.
