ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A4 GLA ROAD (BROMPTON ROAD, ROYAL BOROUGH OF KENSINGTON & CHELSEA) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable water mains refurbishment works to take place on A4 Brompton Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in a westerly direction between the A4 Brompton Road and the A4 Thurloe Place at their junction with the A308 Brompton Road.
The Order will be effective at certain times from 10:00 PM on 4th August 2023 until 5:00 AM on 7th August 2023 or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: Brompton Road southbound, Fulham Road, Finborough Road northbound, Warwick Road to normal route of travel. [For cyclists] Brompton Road, Alexander Place, Thurloe Square, Thurloe Place to normal route of travel.
