ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (EPSOM ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable carriageway resurfacing works to take place on the Epsom Road.
 The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering,

proceeding or stopping on Epsom Road between its junctions with

- Stafford Road and Purley Way.

 The Order will be effective at certain times from 07:00 AM 10th
 September 2023 until 7:00 PM 10th February 2024 or when the works
 have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply
 only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
 indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be
 - indicated by traffic signs via Dupass Hill Road, Croydon Flyover, Dupass Hill Road, Stafford Road, Plough Lane and Croydon Road to normal route of travel.
