ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA ROAD (LONDON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF CROYDON) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable gully repair works to take place at A23 London Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding on southern arm of the unnamed service road frontings Nos.793 to 795 London Road between its junction with

London Road and a point 4 metres north of the extended common

- The Order will be effective from 07:00 AM 1st September 2023 until LI:59 PM 30th November 2023 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

boundary of No.791 and No.793 London Road.

- (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
