ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A501 GLA ROAD (OLD MARYLEBONE, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) (No.2) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London in consultation with the City of Westminster hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above-named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable crane works to take place on the A501 Old Marylebone Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, proceeding or stopping on Old Marylebone Road between its junctions with Chapel Street and Marylebone Road;
 - (2) entering or proceeding in a north-easterly direction on Old Marylebone Road between its junctions with Edgware Road and Chapel Street, local access will be maintained;
 - (3) entering York Street westbound at its junction with Seymour Place, local access will be maintained;

The Order will also permit two-way operation on:

- (4) Harcourt Street between its junctions with Old Marylebone Road and York Street;
- (5) York Street between its junctions with Harcourt Street and Seymour Place.

Works will be phased such that some restrictions will apply only at certain times.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 18th August 2023 and 4th December 2023, every Friday 10:00 PM until 5:00 AM Monday or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. For Marylebone Road via Sussex Gardens, Sale Place, Praed Street, Edgware Road, Harrow Road westbound, Harrow Roundabout and Harrow Road eastbound to normal route of travel. For Edgware Road/ Old Marylebone Road via Marylebone Flyover, Harrow Road, Bishop's Bridge Road, Westbourne Terrace and Sussex Gardens to normal route of travel.
