### **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ARISTOTLE ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable telecommunication works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily:

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that length of Aristotle Road, which lies between the junctions of Bedford Road and Clapham High Street for a length of approximately 25 metres.
- (b) suspend the One - Way working system and introduce a Two-Way system from the junction with Clapham High Street to the south-eastern property boundary of No. 40 Aristotle Road.

2. An alternative route for affected vehicles will be available via Clapham High Street, Tremadoc Road and Bedford Road.

3. The ban and suspension will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs. Access for residents will be maintained.

4. The Order will come into force on 14th September 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works will take place between 14th September 2023 and 19th September 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order will also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 2 months.
