

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – CARLISLE
LANE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable bridge examination works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Carlisle Lane which lies between the junction of Westminster Bridge Road and the junction with Royal Street.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via:-

(a) Westminster Bridge Road, Lambeth Palace Road, Royal Street.

(b) Cycles on diversion will follow the agreed diversion route:-Centaur Street, Hercules Road, Kennington Road and Westminster Bridge Road.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 18th September 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will be carried out between 18th September 2023 at 10pm to 19th September 2023 at 6am, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates then the Order may also have effect on subsequent days within the maximum period of 2 months.
