ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS – CARLISLE
LANE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable bridge examination works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, subject to the agreement of Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Carlisle Lane which lies between the junction of Westminster Bridge Road and the junction with Royal Street.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via:-

(a) Westminster Bridge Road, Lambeth Palace Road, Royal Street.

(b) Cycles on diversion will follow the agreed diversion route:-Centaur Street, Hercules Road, Kennington Road and Westminster Bridge Road.

3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 18th September 2023 for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would be carried out between 18th September 2023 at 10pm to 19th September 2023 at 6am, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates then the Order may also have effect on subsequent days within the maximum period of 2 months.
