ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ESTREHAM ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Thames Water maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with the Transport for London, intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Estreham Road, which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 50/51 and 52/53 Estreham Road and the south-western boundary of No. 1 Hambro Road.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be provided via:

(a) Natal Road, Streatham High Road, Kempshott Road, Ellison Road, Guildersfield Road, Streatham High Road and Barrow Road; and

(b) Barrow Road, Streatham High Road and Natal Road.

3. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 25th September 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works would be completed on the 25th September 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order would also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 3 months.
