ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – GLENELDON MEWS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Southern Gas Network new service works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, in agreement with the Transport for London, have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that section of Gleneldon Mews, which lies between the southern kerb-line of Gleneldon Road and a point 17 metres south of that kerb-line.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be provided via:

(a) Gleneldon Road, Bournevale Road and Stanthorpe Road: and

(b) Stanthorpe Road, Ashlake Road, Gleneldon Road, Shrubbery Road, Streatham High Road and Gleneldon Road.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 25th September 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the works will take place between the 25th September 2023 and the 29th September 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order will also have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 3 months.
