## LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

## TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - IDMISTON ROAD 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable Lead pipe

- replacement works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be at certain times to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Idmiston Road which lies:
- (a) between the junctions of Rosendale Road and Chancellor Grove; (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Rosendale Road, Eastmearn Road, Tulsemere Road, Idmiston Road and vice- versa):
  - Tulsemere Road; (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Idmiston Road, Rosendale Road, Tulsemere Road and vice-versa); (c) between the junctions of Tulsemere Road and

(b) between the junctions of Chancellor Grove and

- Barston Road; (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Tulsemere Road, Towton Road, Ardlui Road, Idmiston Road and viceversa);

  (d) between the junctions of Barston Road and Ardlui
- Road; (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Idmiston Road, Tulsemere Road Towton Road, Ardlui Road and vice-versa); (e) between the junctions of Ardlui Road and
- Chatsworth Way; (alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available via Ardlui Road, Chatsworth Way and vice versa.

  2. The road closure would only apply at such times and to
- such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

  3. It is anticipated that the restrictions referred to in paragraph 1(a),(b),(c),(d),(e) and (f) above would be carried
- 3. It is anticipated that the restrictions referred to in paragraph 1(a),(b),(c),(d),(e) and (f) above would be carried out in 5 phases so that the Order would not apply to the whole lengths of road in the above paragraph at any one time and that access for residents would be maintained where possible.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 19th September 2023 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 6 months, or until the works have been completed, whichever is earlier. If the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time, then the Order may have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 6 months.
