ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A5 GLA ROAD (EDGWARE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2023

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable telecom ducting and chamber works to take place on the A5 Edgware Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning right from the north-westbound carriageway of Edgware Road into Harrowby Street.

The Order will be effective at certain times between 16th September 2023 and 8th October 2023, every Saturday 8:00 AM until 4:00 PM Sunday or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Burwood Place, Norfolk Crescent, Oxford Square, Hyde Park Crescent, Southwick Street, Sussex Gardens, Old Marylebone Road, Homer Row and Shouldham Street to normal route of travel.
