ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A202 GLA ROAD (VAUXHALL BRIDGE ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2023

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable a tower crane operation to take place on the A202 Vauxhall Bridge Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering or proceeding in a southerly direction on Vauxhall Bridge Road between its junctions with Neathouse Place and Gillingham Street:
 - (2) stopping on Vauxhall Bridge Road between its junctions with Neathouse Place and Gillingham Street.

The Order will be effective between 14 th October 2023 and 3 rd December 2023, every Saturday at 6:00 AM until Sunday at 8:00 PM or until the works has been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Neathouse Place, Bridge Place, Eccleston Bridge, Buckingham Palace Road, Elizabeth Bridge, St George's Drive, Lupus Street, Bessborough Street and Drummond Gate to normal route of travel.
