ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14

TEMPORARY PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLE RESTRICTIONS – ALBERT EMBANKMENT

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate tree reduction pruning, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth after consulting Transport for London (TfL) intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban pedestrians and pedal cyclists from entering that length of Albert Embankment footway between Lambeth Bridge and Westminster Bridge.
2. Alternative routes for pedestrians and pedal cyclists would be available via Lambeth Palace Road (A3036).
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The Order would come into force on 6th November 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place between 6th November 2023 and 10th November 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 2 months.
