TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS – BRIXTON STATION ROAD 1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to facilitate carriageway resurfacing, the Council of the London

- Borough of Lambeth after consulting Transport for London (TfL) intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:(a) suspend the one-way working on Pope's Road to allow two-way working.
- two-way worкing. (b) suspend parking places on Pope's Road and Valentia Place
- (c) ban vehicles from entering that length of:-
 - (1) Brixton Station Road which lies between the junctions of Pope's Road and Barrington Road; and,
 (2) Gresham Road. 20m either side of the junction with
 - Brixton Station Road; and,
 - (3) Pope's Road, 15m north of the junction with Brixton Station Road; and
 - Station Road; and

 (4) Valentia Place between the junctions of Brixton
 Station Road and Cool Lane
- Station Road and Coal Lane.

 2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles would be available:- (a) from Pope's Road, eastbound via Canterbury Crescent, Wiltshire Road, Western Road, St. James's Crescent, and Barrington Road; and (b) from Gresham
- Crescent, and Barrington Road; and (b) from Gresnam Road, north-westbound via Coldharbour Lane, Barrington Road, St. James's Crescent, Fyfield Road, and Wiltshire Road; (c) from Gresham Road, south-eastbound via Western Road, St. James's Crescent, Barrington Road, and Coldharbour Lane; and (d) from Valentia Place,
- Western Road, St. James's Crescent, Barrington Road, and Coldharbour Lane; and (d) from Valentia Place, Coldharbour Lane, and Barrington Road.

 3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
- appropriate traffic signs.

 4. The Order would come into force on 30th October 2023 and would continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works would take place in 3 phases; phase 1 and 3 closures excluding Gresham Road between 30th October and 4th November and 9th November and 10th November 2023. Phase 2 including closure of Gresham Road between 6th November and 9th November

2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have effect at

subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months. **Dated 20th October 2023**
