ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – CLARENCE AVENUE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving new water service connection works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering in that length of Clarence Avenue, which lies between its junction with Poynders Road and a point 60 metres north of Clarence Avenue.

2. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Poynders Road, Rodenhurst Road, Park Hill and vice versa and (ii) Poynders Road, South Circular Road, Atkins Road, Kings Avenue and vice versa.

3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order will come into force on 30th October 2023 and will continue for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow for contingencies) or until the said works have been completed, whichever is sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the Order will only have effect between 30th October 2023 and 9th November 2023, but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the Order will also have effect on subsequent dates within that maximum duration of 3 months.
