PROPOSED INTRODUCTION AND REMOVAL OF DISABLED PARKING PLACES IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH

[NOTE: This Notice is about the removal of disabled parking places where they are no longer required and the introduction of new disabled parking places where they are needed. In controlled parking zones, this would involve (a) the introduction of new parking spaces where the disabled parking places are removed; and (b) the removal of existing parking space to accommodate the new disabled parking places. Objections or other comments may be made [see paragraph 6.]

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth made The Lambeth (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) (Amendment No. 27) Order 2023 and The Lambeth (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No. 25) Order 2023 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

2. The general effect of the Orders is to:-

- (1) remove disabled parking places from the locations specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice;
- (2) introduce new "at any time" disabled parking places at the locations specified in Schedule 2 to this Notice; and,
- (3) where the locations are in a controlled parking zone (CPZ); (a) to extend any parking space adjacent to the locations specified in Schedule 1 to replace the disabled parking place that would be removed, and (b) to reduce/remove any existing parking space at the locations specified in Schedule 2 to accommodate the new disabled parking places.

3. The Orders are necessary to remove certain disabled parking places where they are no longer required and to provide new disabled parking places where they are needed.

6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
