direction via Mepham Street and Waterloo Road. 3. The ban will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. The Order comes into force on 23rd October 2023 and continues for a maximum duration of 3 months (to allow

for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice, it is anticipated that the works will take place between 23rd October 2023 and 9th December 2023, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during that time then the Order may have

effect at subsequent times within the maximum period of 3 months
